Tammy thought the biggest thing was to advertise and have pre-sales. Tickets could be printed at either Northwest Printing or JPDesign (across from Mercy Clinic).

Upcoming events are Mud Volleyball (if Mark is still planning to organize the event), Fall Fest and Christmas in Harvard. Laura suggested we look into joining up with other local organizations such as the Rotary or Lions Club to try and partner with one of their events.
