UDDER MUDDER VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT - SATURDAY, AUGUST 16th

Chairman Marzahl updated the Committee on the Parks & Recreation Committee meeting held last week at which time the Committee voted not to waive fees for the mud volleyball tournament and rodeo. The Events Committee will need to budget approximately \$200 for park usage, the outdoor market fee and one-day liquor license.

The Committee discussed whether or not to try and change the date on the existing banner or just replace the banner. Laura suggested we do a new banner and put the "3rd Saturday of August" instead of the actual date which will allow the Events Committee to reuse the banner each year and perhaps give Ford last year's banner to display. Lori will check with Mark to see how he would like to proceed.

We can just do a ¼ page ad instead of the half page ad we usually split with Movie Night Out since Jay has advised he is not doing the outdoor movie this year. Steph suggested we put something in the Upcoming Events in the July 18th edition which is free and then the ¼ page ad in the August 8th Main Line which comes out the week before the event. Wanda said she would prepare a press release once we get all the information and she will also see if we can get an article in the Boone County Journal. Wanda will also put on Facebook.

Lori will touch base with Mark to advise of the park fees and work on the details for the event so we can get the flyer done and registration applications sent out. We also need to obtain quotes for dram shop insurance.

FALL FEST

Fall Fest has been scheduled for Saturday, October 11th; details will be forthcoming.

OTHER EVENTS

Chairman Marzahl noted an e-mail that Lori received from the Harlem Ambassadors Show Basketball Team who will be touring Illinois in October. They are looking for organizations to host the event. Another suggestion was to host a Donkey Basketball game at the school. The Events Committee could work with a school group on either of the events as a fundraiser for both groups.
