SELF-CARE CORNER

Four Causes of Stress that can impact your everyday.

<u>Life Threat</u>: A traumatic injury due to experience of death-provoking terror, horror, or helplessness.

<u>Loss</u>: A grief injury due to the loss of a cherished person, things, or parts of oneself.

<u>Inner Conflict</u>: A moral injury due to behaviors or the witnessing of behaviors that violate moral values.

<u>Wear & Tear</u>: A fatigue injury due to the accumulation of stress from all sources over time without sufficient rest and recovery.
