City of Harvard Pool Closing and Inclement Weather Policy

Harvard Aquatic Center is subject to early closing if low attendance (10 patrons or less in a two hour period), weather warrants, or for a special program. The aquatic center will close whenever projected high air temperatures for the day are below 68 degrees. If outside temperatures drop below 65 degrees during open swim the pool will be closed.

Lightning poses a serious risk of injury at aquatic facilities. Due to the seriousness of this issue, the following policy has been developed for aquatic facilities managed by the Parks and

Recreation Department. When inclement weather occurs, including but not limited to: Rain, wind, lightening and/or severe conditions (tornado, thunderstorm watch/warnings) that compromise the safety of the patrons or staff, the water will be cleared, staff will remain at the facility and attempt to reopen as soon as possible. If it is not feasible to reopen after 60 minutes, the pool will close
