POSSESSION OF EXPLOSIVES OR EXPLOSIVE OR INCENDIARY DEVICE

On 11-18-19 at approximately 0720 hrs, it was reported to the Harvard Police Department that a Harvard Resident (m-24 yoa) was possibly making and in possession of homemade explosive devices as well as being in possession of an unknown amount of firearms and ammunition with a Revoked Firearm Owners Identification (FOID) card. It was further reported to police that said Resident had possibly made threats towards setting off the devices at unspecified locations.

A multijurisdictional investigation was immediately conducted with the assistance of Agents from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives, and the assistance of McHenry County Animal Control and the Harvard Fire Protection District.

The scene which was located in the 1400 blk Northfield Court has been deemed secure and safe. At no time were residents in the area in danger. The investigation continues and further information will be provided as it's received.

On 11-18-19 at approximately 1720 hrs, Evan G Fazio (m-24 yoa), 1424 Northfield Ct Apt 1B, Harvard was arrest and charged with one count Unlawful Use of Weapon, one count Possession of a Firearm without a Firearms Owner Identification Card and two counts Possession of Ammunition without a Firearms Owner Identification Card. Fazio was subsequently transported to the McHenry Count Jail in lieu of bond.
