CRIMINAL DEFACEMENT

On 12-21-22 at 1521 hrs, Officers observed an unknown person(s) had spray painted the word “Crip” on several residences, signs, and several vehicles located in the 800 blk Dewey St sometime earlier in the day.

On 01-10-23 throughout the evening and on 01-11-23 throughout the day, several more Harvard Residents reported an unknown person(s) had again spray painted the word “Crip” on several residences, and vehicles located in the 700 blk Dewey St, and in the 100 and 200 blk of Galvin Prkwy, all located within the Park Pointe Subdivision.

After a thorough investigation, and the assistance of the public on 01-12-23 at approximately 1114 hrs a Harvard Youth (m-13 yoa) was arrested and charged with One (1) count Criminal Damage to State Supported Property, Nine (9) counts of Criminal Defacement, and One (1) Count Criminal Damage to Property. The Youth was released to a parent and petitioned to McHenry County Court Services.
