Incident: Gunshot Victim in Harvard

The Harvard Police Department and Harvard Fire Protection District responded to a reported gunshot victim in the 100 block of West Brown Street on Saturday, May 4, 2024.

Upon arrival, officers discovered a 39-year-old male victim with a gunshot wound to his right foot in the front yard of the residence. An immediate investigation revealed that the offender, identified as Tyrone D. Jones (36 years old), attempted to flee the scene but was promptly apprehended by responding officers.

Tyrone D. Jones, of 364 Bent Street, Elgin, has been arrested and charged with Unlawful Possession of a Controlled Substance, Resisting a Peace Officer, Criminal Trespass to Residence, and Unlawful Possession of a Firearm by a Felon. Jones is currently in custody at McHenry County Jail awaiting bond.

The victim was swiftly transported by Harvard Fire Protection District to Javon Bea Hospital – Riverside, where he received medical treatment and was subsequently released.

The case is under active investigation, and additional charges may be pending.
