Work is performed under the supervision of the Public Works Superintendent with direction from the Public Works Foreman. Position is on 24-hour call for a week once every 7 weeks, and must be available November through March for snow operations.

Ideal applicant will have a minimum of two (2) years' responsible work experience in public works, landscaping, construction, or related field; or any combination and experience that provides equivalent knowledge, skills, and abilities.
