## It's a Toilet, Not a Trash Can!

Never flush the following items (or put down the garbage disposal or drain). Toss them in the trash instead.

- · Baby/Facial/Cleaning Wipes
- Tampons
- · Sanitary Napkins
- Medication
- Hair
- Dental Floss
- Cotton Swabs/Balls
- Bandages
- · Rags and Towels
- Rubber Items (like latex gloves)
- · Fat, Cooking Oil, Grease



- Clothing Labels
- Candy/Food Wrappers
- Syringes
- Cigarette Butts
- Disposable Toilet Brushes
- Kitty Litter
- Aquarium Gravel
- Plastic Items
- Diapers
- Fruit Stickers
- Paper Towels

## Only Flush the 3 P's - Pee, Poop and (toilet) Paper

Wipes and other items also cause problems in the pipes inside your home. Clogged pipes can lead to overflowing toilets, basement sewer backups and the need to clean out the main drain. When this happens, a plumber is needed to clear the blockage. To help avoid these problems and expenses, only flush human waste and toilet paper.

Take your responsibility seriously. Don't flush wipes or other items that can clog pipes in your home, the sewer system, pump stations and equipment at the City of Harvard's Waste Treatment Plant.
